#### To apply for homeownership:

Visit www.essexcountyhabitat.org/application/ to get an application and instructions for applying. Applications are also available at Hamilton Wenham Public Library and Hamilton Town Hall. Applicants who meet eligibility requirements will be entered into a lottery (to be held on November 16) and, if chosen, will become a prospective Habitat homeowner.

## Deadline to apply is: August 31, 2022

## To qualify:

You must be a first-time homebuyer and have a qualifying household income (see chart). You will also be required to contribute <u>240-360 hours of "sweat equity</u>" working on your home or other Habitat homes.

## **Cost to you:**

- Sales Price: 1BR \$173,000, 2BR \$195,000
  3BR \$217,000
- Closing costs are approximately \$5,000
- Mortgage, taxes, insurance, and condo fees are approximately \$1,400 - \$1,750\*/month
